# MATERIALS LIST

# Honeycomb Scarf

### **Materials**

- Berroco Vintage Chunky bulky (chunky) weight yarn (3½ oz/130 yds/100g per hank):
  - 2 hanks #6180 dried plum or 2 hanks #61190 cerulean
- Size K/10½/6.5mm Tunisian crochet hook, minimum length of 10 inches, or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle



## Stockinette Hat

### RIBBED VERSION

### **Materials**

- Berroco Vintage DK light (DK) weight yarn (3½ oz/288 yds/100g per hank):
  - 1 hank #2107 cracked pepper
- Size H/8/5mm Tunisian crochet hook, minimum length of 14 inches, or size needed to obtain gauge
- Size F/5/3.75mm crochet hook
- Tapestry needle
- · 8 stitch markers

# FELTED VERSION

### **Materials**

- Cascade 220 medium (worsted) weight yarn (31/2 oz/220 yds/100g per hank):
  - 2 hanks #7830 coral
- Size K/10½/6.5mm Tunisian crochet hook, minimum length of 14 inches, or size needed to obtain gauge
- · Tapestry needle
- · Sewing needle
- · Sewing thread
- Prepurchased flower
- · Safety pin or fabric glue

# **Spiraling** Miters **Shawlette**

### **Materials**

- · Plymouth Yarn Boku medium (worsted) weight yarn (134 oz/99 yds/50g per hank):
  - 4 skeins #10 blue multi
- Size L/11/8mm Tunisian crochet hook, minimum length of 10 inches, or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle
