Crochet Stitches Identification Swatch

Materials

- Medium (worsted) weight yarn in colors A and B
- Size H/8/5mm crochet hook





Materials

- · Berroco Vintage medium (worsted) weight acrylic/ wool/nylon yarn (3½ oz/ 218 yds/100g per hank):
 - 1 hank each #5167 dewberry (A), #5123 blush (B), #5100 snow day (C), #5124 kiwi (D) and #5162 envy (E)
- Size H/8/5mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- · Tapestry needle

Solid **Popcorns** Repair Swatch



- Berroco Vintage medium (worsted) weight acrylic/wool/nylon yarn $(3\frac{1}{2} \text{ oz}/218 \text{ yds}/100 \text{ per hank})$: 1 hank #5123 blush
- Size H/8/5mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle

Ripple Repair Swatch

Materials

- Berroco Vintage medium (worsted) weight acrylic/wool/nylon yarn (3½ oz/218 yds/ 100g per hank):
 - 1 hank each #5142 jade (A), #5125 aquae (B), #5100 snow day (C) and #5167 dewberry (D)
- Size H/8/5mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle



Popcorn Rows Mistake Swatch

Materials

- Berroco Vintage medium (worsted) weight acrylic/wool/nylon yarn $(3\frac{1}{2} \text{ oz}/218 \text{ yds}/100 \text{ per hank})$:
 - 1 hank each #5167 dewberry (A) and #5125 aguae (B)
- Size H/8/5mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- · Tapestry needle





Materials

- Berroco Vintage medium (worsted) weight acrylic/wool/nylon yarn (3½ oz/218 yds/ 100g per hank):

 - 1 hank #5125 aguae
- Size H/8/5mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle

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Appliqués for Covering Mistakes & Damage

Materials

- Berroco Vintage medium (worsted) weight acrylic/ wool/nylon yarn (3½ oz/ 218 yds/100g per hank):
 1 hank each #5123 blush (A), #5162 envy (B), #5124 kiwi (C) and #5125 aquae (D)
- Size H/8/5mm crochet hook
- · Tapestry needle
