- Premier Yarns Ever Soft medium (worsted) weight acrylic yarn (3 oz/158 yds/85g per ball):
4 balls #0012 rosey 
- Sizes H/8/5mm and I/9/5.5mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle

Modern Twist Fingerless Mitts




Materials

- Premier Yarns Ever Soft medium (worsted) weight acrylic yarn (3 oz/158 yds/85g per ball):
1 ball #0024 Celtic 
- Size G/6/4mm crochet hook or sizes needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle
- Stitch marker

Intertwined Jewels Cabled Pillow



Materials

- Premier Yarns Deborah Norville Everyday Soft Worsted medium (worsted) weight acrylic yarn (4 oz/203 yds/113g per ball):
3 balls #1032 peony 
- Sizes H/8/5mm and I/9/5.5mm crochet hooks or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle
- Stitch markers: 6–8
- 16-inch-square pillow form
- 2-inch x 5-inch piece of cardboard
