Materials

- Plymouth Encore Worsted medium (worsted) weight acrylic/wool yarn (3½ oz/200 yds/100g per ball):

1½ oz/86 yds/43g #1307 beach peach

½ oz/29 yds/14g #1385 bright fuchsia

2 yds #1382 bright yellow

- Black embroidery floss
- Size F/5/3.75mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle
- Sewing needle
- Stitch markers
- Fiberfill
- 9mm black buttons: 2
- Matching sewing thread

Daisy Duck

Materials

- Plymouth Encore Worsted medium (worsted) weight acrylic/wool yarn (3½ oz/200 yds/100g per ball):

1½ oz/86 yds/43g #1382 bright yellow

½ oz/29 yds/14g each #1383 bright orange and #0471 blue hydrangea

- Size F/5/3.75mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle
- Sewing needle
- Stitch markers
- Fiberfill
- 9mm brown buttons: 2
- Matching sewing thread



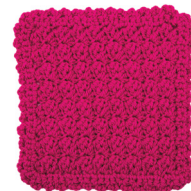
2 yds each #1382 bright yellow, #0217 black and #0218 champagne
Small amounts #0137 California pink and #3335 Rio lime

- Black embroidery floss
- Size F/5/3.75mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle
- Sewing needle
- Stitch markers
- Fiberfill
- 9mm brown buttons: 2
- ½-inch white button: 1
- Matching sewing thread

Blankie

Materials

- Plymouth Encore Worsted medium (worsted) weight acrylic/wool yarn (3½ oz/200 yds/100g per ball):
- 1½ oz/87 yds/43g desired color
- Size H/8/5mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
 - Tapestry needle



Frankie Frog

Materials

- Plymouth Encore Worsted medium (worsted) weight acrylic/wool yarn (3½ oz/200 yds/100g per ball):
- 1½ oz/86 yds/43g #3335 Rio lime
- 8 yds #1382 bright yellow
- 2 yds #1383 bright orange
- 1 yd each #1385 bright fuchsia and #0218 champagne
- Black embroidery floss
 - Size F/5/3.75mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge



Mr. Fox

Materials

- Plymouth Encore Worsted medium (worsted) weight acrylic/wool yarn (3½ oz/200 yds/100g per ball):
- 1½ oz/86 yds/43g #0456 harvest
- ½ oz/29 yds/14g #1446 meadow heather
