# Andi Lace Raglan Sweater

## **Materials**

- Universal Yarn Nazli
  Gelin Garden size 5
  crochet cotton
  (1¾ oz/174 yds/50g per ball):
  3 [4, 4, 5, 5, 5] balls #73 light grey
  3 [3, 3, 3, 4, 4] balls #74 steel grey
- Size E/4/3.5mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle
- · Straight pins
- Stitch markers



# Ruby Top-Down Pullover

## **Materials**

- Berroco Vintage DK light (DK) weight acrylic/wool/nylon yarn (3½ oz/288 yds/100g per hank): 3 [3, 4, 4, 5, 5] hanks #21181 ruby
- Size 7/4.5mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle
- · Straight pins
- Stitch markers

# **Brooklyn Motif Tunic**

#### **Materials**

- Universal Yarn
   Uptown DK light (DK) weight acrylic yarn (3½ oz/273 yds/100g per skein):
  - 4 [4, 5, 6, 6, 7] skeins #114 sea
- Size crochet hook needed for garment size and to obtain gauge
- · Tapestry needle
- · Straight pins
- · Stitch markers
