MATERIALS LIST

Easy-Peasy Sweater Beanies



Materials

- Sweater in desired color or pattern
- Simple knit hat that fits well, to use for pattern
- Newsprint or paper bag
- Fabric-marking pen
- Measuring tape
- Craft scissors
- Fabric scissors
- Pins
- Sewing machine with 90/14 needle or hand-sewing needle
- Complementary thread
- Steam iron and ironing board

Sassy No-Sew Sweater Boot Socks



Materials

- Sweater with long sleeves
- Fabric scissors
- Liquid seam sealant
- 2 decorative buttons
- Pins
- Hand-sewing needle and complementary thread

Decorative Throw Pillows



Materials

- Sweater
- New or recycled pillow form
- Measuring tape
- Fabric scissors
- Washable fabric marker
- Straight edge
- Pins
- Sewing machine or hand-sewing needle and complementary thread
- Contrasting embroidery floss, decorative buttons or other embellishments (optional)

Nifty Gifty Sweater Bottle Bags



Materials

- Sweater with long sleeves
- Fabric scissors
- Fabric-marking pen
- Straight edge
- Measuring tape
- Pins
- Complementary ribbon
- Sewing machine or hand-sewing needle and thread

Dapper Doggy Sweater



Materials

- Sweater with a fun design, plus an optional complementary or contrasting sweater
- Measuring tape
- Fabric scissors
- Pins
- Sewing machine and complementary thread

Cozy & Fleecy 1-Hour Smittens



Materials

- 2 coordinating sweaters: 1 with a pattern, 1 plain
- ¼ yard complementary fleece fabric
- 2 decorative buttons
- Fabric scissors
- Measuring tape
- Pins
- Sewing machine or hand-sewing needle and thread

Sweater Tablet Tote



Materials

- Acrylic cardigan
- ½ yard lining fabric
- 2 wooden handles
- 1½ yards heavy-weight fusible interfacing
- Fabric scissors
- Fabric-marking pen
- Straight edge
- Sewing machine
- Hand-sewing needle and thread
- Iron and ironing board
- Pins
- Complementary/contrasting embroidery floss

Make It Merry Sweater Ornaments & Tree Skirt



Materials

Ornaments

- 3-inch plastic foam balls
- Sweater(s) in fun color/pattern(s)
- Pins
- Hot-glue gun and glue stick
- Decorative ribbon: 1 (8-inch) piece and 1 (16-inch) piece for each ornament
- Decorative buttons
- Measuring tape
- Sharp pencil
- Fabric scissors
- Sewing machine or hand-sewing needle and thread

Tree Skirt

- Sweater with patterned yoke measuring at least 14 inches
- Fabric scissors
- Pins
- Knit bias tape
- Sewing machine or hand-sewing needle and thread
