MATERIALS LIST

Sweet Pink Fairy Earrings



Materials

- CRYSTALLIZED™ Swarovski Elements: 2 (6mm) white opal bicone crystals, 2 (6mm) white pearl rounds
- 2 (14 x 10mm) wine frosted petunia Lucite flower beads
- 2 (2-inch) 21-gauge silver-plated head pins
- 2 (17mm) 22-gauge silver-plated brass fishhook ear wires (with 2mm ball)
- Round-nose pliers
- Chain-nose pliers
- Flush cutter

Oh So Vintage Earrings



Materials

- 2 (2.5mm) light Colorado topaz CRYSTALLIZED™ Swarovski Elements bicone crystals
- 2 (8mm) cocoa pearl beads
- 2 (4mm) antique brass pumpkin beads
- 2 (15mm flat) antique brass five-petal bead caps
- 2 (2-inch) antique brass head pins
- 2 antique bronze vintage-style lever-back ear wires
- Round-nose pliers
- Chain-nose pliers
- Flush cutter

Charming Bauble Bracelets



Materials

- 5 large red Asian crystal beads
- 5 (4mm) clear crystal round beads
- 5 (15mm flat) antique brass five-petal bead caps
- 6 (¾-inch length) antique bronze double-link chains
- 5 (2-inch) antique brass head pins
- 2 (7mm) antique brass jump rings
- 1 (14 x 8mm) antique brass lobster-claw clasp
- Round-nose pliers
- Chain-nose pliers
- Flush cutter

Island Elegance Earrings



Materials

- 8 (6mm) dark green round glass beads
- Pearl beads: 2 (12mm) teal, 4 (10mm) dark cream
- 2 (2-inch lengths) gold chain
- 14 (2-inch) .8mm gold thick head pins
- 2 gold ear wires
- Round-nose pliers
- Chain-nose pliers
- Flush cutter

Simply Strung Bracelet



Materials

- 18 (6mm) black round glass beads
- 6 (8mm) clear crystal faceted round beads
- 3 (13 x 8.5mm) Artisan lampwork glass beads
- 8-inch length of satin silver 7-strand beading wire
- 2 silver crimp tubes
- 1 silver-plated toggle clasp
- Crimp tool
- Chain-nose pliers
- Flush cutter

Additional Materials for Multiple Strand Verison



- 5 (8mm) AB crystal round beads
- Size 6/0 blue seed beads
- Size 8/0 silver seed beads
- 4 silver crimp tubes
- 2 (6mm) silver-plated jump rings
- 2 (8-inch) lengths of satin silver 7-strand beading wire

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Simply Strung Earrings



Materials

- 4 (6mm) round black glass beads
- 4 (8mm) clear round faceted crystal beads
- 2 (13 x 8.5mm) Artisan lampwork glass beads
- 2 (4-inch) lengths of satin silver 7-strand beading wire
- 2 silver crimp tubes
- 2 silver-plated collette covers
- 2 silver-plated ear wires
- Crimp tool
- Chain-nose pliers
- Flush cutter

Elegantly Strung Floating Necklace



Materials

- 10 (6mm) round black beads
- 6 (8mm) clear round faceted crystal beads
- 1 (13 x 8.5mm) Artisan lampwork glass bead
- 19-inch length of satin silver 7-strand beading wire
- 12 silver crimp tubes
- 2 silver crimp tube covers

- 1 silver-plated toggle clasp
- Crimp tool
- Chain-nose pliers
- Flush cutter

Yellow Rose Necklace & Ring



Materials

- CRYSTALLIZED™ Swarovski Elements:
 - 4 (6mm) white pearls, 6 (6mm) light yellow bicone crystals
- 2 yellow resin rose cabochons
- 18-inch length silver-plated elongated chain
- 4 (2-inch) 21-gauge silver-plated head pins
- 2 (6mm) silver-plated jump rings
- Silver-plated toggle clasp
- Silver leaf bail
- Silver adjustable ring blank
- E-6000 glue
- Round-nose pliers
- Chain-nose pliers
- Flush cutter

Vintage Rose Earrings



Materials

- 2 (6mm) cream CRYSTALLIZED™ Swarovski Elements pearl beads
- 2 blue roses on cream disc cabochons

- 2 antique brass square filigrees
- 2 (2-inch) antique brass head pins
- 2 antique brass French ear wires
- E-6000 glue
- Round-nose pliers
- Chain-nose pliers
- Flush cutter
- Small metal hole punch

Altered Game Tile Necklace



Materials

- 6 green and pink large-holed beads from 9-piece mix
- 2 silver large-holed bead cones
- 2 silver cord ends
- 2 (6mm) silver-plated jump rings
- 1 silver-plated toggle clasp
- 1 silver leaf bail
- 1 letter tile from board game
- Scrap of patterned paper
- 16-inch length cream satin rattail cording
- Diamond Glaze adhesive
- E-6000 glue
- Chain-nose pliers
- Super glue
- Craft knife
- Cutting mat
