MATERIALS LIST

Sideways-Striped Hat

Materials

 Filatura Di Crosa Sportwool (DK weight; 100% pure new wool superwash; 136 yds/50g per ball):
Hat 1: 1 ball each dark orchid heather #1672 (A) and teal heather #1681 (B)
Hat 2: 1 ball each charcoal heather #1363 (C) and dark denim heather #1682

Hat 3: 1 ball each dark orchid heather #1672 (A), dark denim heather #1682 (D) and charcoal heather #1363 (C)

- Size 6 (4mm) needles or size needed to obtain gauge
- Stitch marker





Cozy Fit Knit Slippers

Materials

- Berroco Lodge (chunky weight; 47% wool/47% acrylic/6% nylon; 98 yds/50g per ball): 1 (2, 2, 2) ball(s) Moab #7429
- Size 9 (5.5mm) double-point needles (set of 4), or size needed to obtain gauge

Downtown Geometric Scarf

Materials

- Classic Elite Yarns Magnolia (DK weight; 70% merino wool/30% silk; 120 yds/50g per ball): 2 balls plum #5456 (A); 1 ball each mauve #5454 (B) and forget-me-not #5448 (C)
- Size 9 (5.5mm) needles or size needed to obtain gauge

Uptown Color Block Capelet

Materials

- Ewe Ewe Yarns Wooly Worsted (worsted weight; 100% merino superwash wool; 95 yds/50g per ball): 1 skein each red poppy #20 (A), teal #60 (B) and indigo #80 (C), 2 skeins saffron #30 (D)
- Size 7 (4.5mm) 24-inch circular and double-point needles (set of 2), or size needed to obtain gauge
- 1 (% inch) button
