

# Learn to Knit Amigurumi

## MATERIALS LIST

### Billy Bunny

#### Materials

- Plymouth Encore Worsted (worsted weight; 75% acrylic/25% wool; 200 yds/100g per ball): 60 yds Rimouski #6002 (A); 25 yds blue hydrangea #0471 (B); 4 yds pale peach #0597 (C)
- Size 3 pearl cotton or embroidery floss: 2 yds each black, orange and green
- Size 5 (3.75mm) knitting needles
- 2 (9mm) buttons or safety eyes
- Fiberfill stuffing
- 2-inch-wide piece of cardboard
- Small and large blunt-end tapestry needles



### Miss Kitty

#### Materials

- Plymouth Encore Worsted (worsted weight; 75% acrylic/25% wool; 200 yds/100g per ball): 60 yds burnished heather #1445 (MC); 35 yds honeysuckle #0467 (CC)
- Size 3 pearl cotton or embroidery floss: 2 yds each in black, blue, yellow and green
- Size 5 (3.75mm) knitting needles
- 2 (9mm) buttons or safety eyes
- Fiberfill stuffing
- Small and large blunt-end tapestry needles



### Blankie

#### Materials

- Plymouth Encore Worsted (worsted weight; 75% acrylic/25% wool; 200 yds/100g per ball): approx 85 yds of any color left over from amigurumi
- Size 7 (4.5mm) knitting needles
- Stitch markers



### Mr. Mouse

#### Materials

- Plymouth Encore Worsted (worsted weight; 75% acrylic/25% wool; 200 yds/100g per ball): 60 yds fox #6003 (MC); 25 yds bright yellow #1384 (A); 9 yds lagoon #0459 (B)
- Size 3 pearl cotton or embroidery floss: 2 yds black
- Carpet thread in off-white (for whiskers)
- Size 5 (3.75mm) knitting needles
- 2 (9mm) buttons or safety eyes
- Fiberfill stuffing
- Small and large blunt-end tapestry needles



### Daisy Dog

#### Materials

- Plymouth Encore Worsted (worsted weight; 75% acrylic/25% wool; 200 yds/100g per ball): 60 yds deep brown #0599 (A); 20 yds French vanilla #0470 (B); 6 yds lagoon #0459 (C); 35 yds purple prelude #0452 (D)
- Size 3 pearl cotton or embroidery floss: 2 yds black
- Size 5 (3.75mm) knitting needles
- 2 (9mm) buttons or safety eyes
- Fiberfill stuffing
- Small and large blunt-end tapestry needles
