MATERIALS LIST

Holiday Charm Ornament & Card

Ornament Materials

- 1 (6-inch) square 14-count antique white Aida
- 1 skein No. 5 red pearl cotton*
- Size 22 tapestry
- 1 (11/4-11/2-inch) holiday charm
- Fabric glue
- ½ yard coordinating ribbon
- 1 (3-inch) embroidery hoop
- · Craft knife
- Basic sewing supplies and equipment

*Sample was made with DMC No. 5 pearl cotton #666 bright red.

Card **Materials**

- 1 (6-inch) square 14-count royal blue Aida*
- 1 skein No. 5 ecru pearl cotton*
- Size 22 tapestry needle
- Fabric glue
- 1 (41/4 x 51/2-inch) trifold card with envelope
- Adhesive tape
- · Basic sewing tools and equipment

*Sample was made with DMC No. 5 pearl cotton ecru.



Materials

- ¾ yard huck toweling
- 1 skein No. 5 blue pearl cotton*
- Size 22 tapestry needle
- Basic sewing supplies and equipment

*Sample was made with DMC No. 5 pearl cotton #797 royal blue.

Skylark Tote

Materials

- ¾ yard 11-count natural Aida
- ½ yard fabric coordinating with thread
- ½ yard heavy-weight fusible interfacing*
- 2 balls (or 4 skeins) each No. 5 coordinating light- and dark-color pearl cotton*
- Size 20 tapestry needle
- Basic sewing supplies and equipment

*Sample was made with Pellon® 808 Craft-Fuse® heavy-weight interfacing and Presencia No. 5 pearl cotton #1485 coral and #1490 dark coral.



Crossroads Runner

Materials

- ½ yard antique white Stockholm or popkorn fabric
- 1 ball each No. 3 pearl cotton in desired light and dark colors*
- Size 13 or 20 tapestry needle (refer to Weaving Wisdom: Needles on page 34)
- Basic sewing supplies and equipment

*Sample was made with Lizbeth No. 3 pearl cotton in #691 mocha brown medium and #692 mocha brown dark.



Materials

- 2¼ yards monk's cloth in desired color
- 1 skein sport, DK or worsted weight yarn in desired dark
- 1 skein sport, DK or worsted weight yarn in desired light color
- Size 13 tapestry needle
- · Basic sewing supplies and equipment


MATERIALS LIST

Materials

- ¾ yard 14-count antique white Aida
- 1/8 yard coordinating cotton print
- 2 balls (or 4 skeins) No. 5 green pearl cotton*
- #22 tapestry needle
- · Basic sewing supplies and equipment
