- Patterned papers: me & my BIG Ideas 12 x 12 paper pads (Baby Girl); Graphic 45 (Little Darlings Bundle of Joy)
- K&Company Itsy Bitsy Die-Cut Cardstock: Baby Girl
- FabScraps Metal Word Embellishments (ME008): Baby
- Ranger Tim Holtz 1-inch-wide Curio Knob
- ⅝-inch-wide desired color ribbon
- Self-adhesive white pearls
- Assorted baby embellishments
- Punches: We R Memory Keepers (Big Bite hole); Martha Stewart Crafts (Swirling Lace punch around the page set, Eyelet Lace), decorative corner, 2-inch circle (optional; used in video)

- Scoring board with bone folder
- Craft knife with extra blades
- Pencil and pen
- Self-healing mat
- Paper trimmer with extra cutting blades
- Ruler
- Hot-glue gun
- Tape
- 3M quick-dry wet adhesive
- Scor-Pal double-sided adhesive (dry adhesive): ¼-inch-wide, ½-inch-wide
- Computer with printer

- K&Company Itsy Bitsy Die-Cut Cardstock: Baby Boy

- FabScraps Metal Word Embellishments (ME008): Baby
- Ranger Tim Holtz 1-inch-wide Curio Knob
- ⅝-inch-wide desired color ribbon
- Self-adhesive white pearls
- Assorted baby embellishments
- Punches: We R Memory Keepers (Big Bite hole); Martha Stewart Crafts (Train Edger)
- Scoring board with tool
- Craft knife
- Self-healing mat
- Paper trimmer
- Ruler
- Hot-glue gun
- 3M quick-dry wet adhesive
- Scor-Pal double-sided adhesive: ¼-inch-wide, ½-inch-wide
