MATERIALS LIST

Starry Holiday Wishes



Materials

- Cardstock: kraft, pink
- Pink self-adhesive glitter paper
- Patterned vellum
- "Happy Holidays" sentiment stamp
- Black dye ink pad
- Sequins or confetti
- Star punches: small (7/8-inch), large (1 1/8-inch)
- Sewing machine with silver thread or stapler
- Scoring board or bone folder and paper trimmer
- Adhesive foam squares
- Paper adhesive

Oh Holy Night



Materials

- Cardstock: black, smooth white
- Black-and-gold polka-dot patterned paper
- Heat-transfer gold foil sheets
- Gold striped washi tape
- Oh Holy Night template*
- Iron or laminating machine
- Parchment paper or pressing paper (optional)
- Scoring board or bone folder and paper trimmer
- Paper adhesive
- Laser-jet printer

Merry & Bright

Materials

- Cardstock: black, red
- White drawing paper
- Merry & Bright template*
- Black fine-tip marker
- Red fine-tip pen
- Enamel dots: black, gold glitter
- Pencil
- Eraser
- Ruler
- Scoring board or bone folder and paper trimmer
- Adhesive foam squares
- Paper adhesive

Christmas Greetings Tag Card



Materials

- Holiday journaling cards:
 - 1 (4 x 6-inch patterned),
 - 1 (3 x 4-inch for message)
- 4 x 4-inch photo
- Fine-tip pen
- Small alphabet and holiday-themed stickers
- Red enamel dot

- Black/white baker's twine
- Hole reinforcement stickers
- Sewing machine with silver thread or stapler
- 1/4-inch hole punch
- Scoring board or bone folder and paper trimmer
- Paper adhesive

Let It Snow



Materials

- Cardstock: aqua glitter, gray, white
- Coffee filters that measure approximately 8 1/4 inches in diameter
- Snowflake templates*
- Aqua spray ink
- Wood veneer snowflakes or other embellishments such as sequins, rhinestones or enamel dots
- White acrylic paint
- Paintbrush
- Scoring board or bone folder and paper trimmer
- Precision-tip scissors
- Clear glitter glue
- Adhesive foam squares
- Paper adhesive

MATERIALS LIST

Watercolor Greeting Card



Materials

- Red striped patterned paper
- Watercolor paper
- Christmas tree stamp
- Black solvent ink pad
- Watercolor paints
- Glitter pens: black, gold
- Enamel dots: white glitter, shades of green
- 5/8-inch-wide red grosgrain ribbon
- Paintbrush and small container of water or waterbrush
- Scoring board or bone folder and paper trimmer
- Gold glitter glue
- Adhesive foam squares
- Paper adhesive

Happy Holidays



Materials

- Cardstock: green polka-dot embossed, red, white
- LJD Christmas Labels and Tags stamp set
- Green dye ink pad
- VersaMark watermark ink pen
- Gold metallic embossing powder
- 5/8-inch-wide red/white grosgrain striped ribbon
- Embossing heat tool
- Precision-tip scissors
- 1 3/4 x 1 1/4-inch oval punch (optional)
- Scoring board or bone folder and paper trimmer
- Gold glitter glue
- Adhesive foam squares
- Paper adhesive

Washi Tape Wreath Card



Materials

- Cardstock: white, red
- Various green, red and gold patterned washi tapes
- Red glitter tape
- Red enamel dots in various sizes
- Red brad or button
- Red/white baker's twine
- Circle template or a circular shape approximately 3 1/4 inches in diameter
- Stapler
- Scoring board or bone folder and paper trimmer
- Adhesive foam squares
- Paper adhesive

O Christmas Tree Card



Materials

- Purple cardstock
- Gold paper
- Old book pages
- Sequins
- Green paint pen
- Star punch
- Sewing machine with silver thread or metallic journaling pen
- Scoring board or bone folder and paper trimmer
- Paper adhesive



Holiday Shaker Postcard

Materials

- 4 x 6-inch photo
- Pink polka-dot patterned vellum
- Stamps: postcard, snowflakes, "Let it snow!"
- Ink pads: black solvent, VersaMark watermark
- Black permanent pen
- White embossing powder
- Sequins
- Embossing heat tool
- Sewing machine with silver thread or extra-strong scrapbooking adhesive
- Scoring board or bone folder and paper trimmer
