MATERIALS LIST

Ode to Poppies Wall Hanging



Materials

- 1 fat quarter each medium and dark red/orange and 2 olive greens
- 1 fat quarter cream batik for A background
- 1/8 yard yellow batik for B/C inner borders
- 5/8 yard black solid for appliqué, D/E outer borders and binding
- Backing 24" x 30"
- Batting 24" x 30"
- Neutral-color thread
- Threads to match fabrics
- 1 1/2 yards paper-backed fusible web
- 11" x 17" sheet tracing paper
- 18" x 20" (or larger) appliqué pressing sheet
- Blue painter's tape
- Mechanical pencil
- Basic sewing tools and supplies

- E4 Elan Embroidery Scissors
- DMC Cotton Machine Embroidery Thread No. 50 wt.
