

# Free Motion-Fills Table Runner

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## MATERIALS LIST

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### Free Motion-Fills Table Runner



### Materials

- 5 solid (no print) fabrics for center diamond and radiating diamonds,  $\frac{1}{4}$  yd each; fat quarters are fine
- Border and binding,  $\frac{3}{4}$  yd
- Backing, either  $1\frac{1}{8}$  yds for pieced backing or  $1\frac{5}{8}$  yds for whole backing
- Batting, 20" x 60", thin cotton recommended for this first project
- Thread, 50 wt. cotton
- Basic sewing tools and supplies including sewing machine with a free-motion foot
- 6" x 12" ruler with 60-degree mark or 60-degree ruler; Clearview Triangle Ruler is shown
- Quilting gloves for easily moving the project
- Permanent marker
- 8½" x 11" copy paper, 10–20 sheets
- Blue painters tape or masking tape
- Piece of plastic, 2" x 2", to tape to the sewing machine bed so ink does not transfer to sewing machine. Easy-to-find plastic like a baggie, wax paper or the plastic window from an envelope will work.
