Flagstones & Heather Quilt



Construction Materials

- Variety purple scraps, at least 3½" square
- Variety green scraps, at least 3½" square
- ¾ yard light violet*
- ⅔ yard light plum*
- ¾ yard moss*
- ⅞ yard eggplant*
- 2½ yards plum*
- Backing to size
- Batting to size**
- Thread for piecing
- Basic sewing tools and supplies

Quilting Materials

- White basting thread*
- Hand-quilting thread*
 - #40 taupe
 - #40 white or neutral
- Needles*
 - #7 long darning for basting
 - #9 or #10 John James between for quilting

- Long large-head straight pins
- 14" quilting hoop*
- Quilting stencils**
 - PCW162 Welsh Hearts & Tulip
 - PCW163 Doily Star & Circling Cranes
 - PC1011 Leafy Branch Braid Border
- Tracing paper on a roll
- Pencil
- Extra fine-point black marker
- Template plastic
- Marking tools*
 - Hera™ marker by Clover®
 - Gray & white marking pencils
 - Chalk wheel with white chalk
 - 6" clear ruler or square with ¼" edge line

Construction Materials

- 1 fat quarter light yellow/green solid*
- ⅛ yard each solid*:
 - red
 - green
 - aqua
 - gold
 - dark blue
 - yellow/green
 - white



- ⅓ yard medium blue solid*
- ½ yard orange solid*
- Batting to size**
- Backing to size
- Thread for piecing**
- Template material
- Basic sewing tools and supplies

Quilting Materials

- White basting thread*
- Hand-quilting thread*
 - #40 white
- Needles*
 - #7 long darning for basting
 - #22 chenille or #4 embroidery for quilting

- Quilting stencils**
 - PCW408 4-Petal Motif
- Marking tool*
 - White chalk marking pencil

Construction Materials

- 1 fat quarter coordinating dark blue solid*
- 1/8 yard each coordinating*:
 - gray/green print orange tonal
 - gold/orange plaid rust print
- 1 yard large-scale Oriental print
- 1 yard muslin
- 1 yard batting**
- Thread for piecing
- Basic sewing tools and supplies

Quilting Materials

- White basting thread*
- Hand-quilting thread*
 - #8 pearl ivory cotton for sashiko
 - #8 pearl cotton for big stitch:
 - taupe
 - dark brown
 - dark blue
- Needles*
 - #7 long darning for basting
 - #22 chenille or #4 embroidery for quilting
- Long large-head straight pins
- Quilting stencils**
 - PCW1052 Pine/Asinoha
 - PCW118 Wisteria Plume/Folding Fans
 - PCW164 Plover (rising birds)
- Marking tools*
 - Hera™ marker by Clover®
 - White chalk marking pencil
 - 6" clear ruler
