Materials

- Variety T-shirts, any size
- Coordinating 100 percent cotton fabric for sashing, borders and binding
- Low loft polyester batting to size*
- Backing to size
- Lightweight woven fusible stabilizer*
- Basic sewing tools and supplies

Family Vacation Quilt

Materials

- Variety T-shirts, any size
- 100 percent cotton fabric for block framing, sashing, borders and binding
- Low loft polyester batting to size*
- Backing to size
- Lightweight woven fusible stabilizer*
- Basic sewing tools and supplies

Double-Framed Pillow

Materials

- T-shirt, any size
- 100 percent cotton fabric for borders and backing
- Muslin for pillow top lining
- Low loft polyester batting to size*
- Lightweight woven fusible stabilizer*
- Purchased pillow form to size
- Basic sewing tools and supplies
