
## Floral Table Runner


#### **Materials**

- 1 fat eighth each blue, pink and green tonals
- 1 fat eighth each coordinating blue, pink and green small-scale florals
- 1/3 yard coordinating stripe
- ¾ yard white solid
- · Backing to size
- · Batting to size
- Approximately 300 (¾") hexagon English paper-piecing papers
- Purchased paper-piecing template or plastic template material
- Paper
- · Sewline glue pen
- Size No. 8 straw needle
- Serrated scissors
- Thread
- Basic sewing tools and supplies

# Flower Bouquet Wall Hanging

#### **Materials**





- 1 fat quarter each light and dark brown tonals
- ¼ yard blue tonal print
- 1 yard cream tonal
- · Backing to size
- · Batting to size
- Approximately 400 (¾") hexagon English paper-piecing papers
- Purchased paper-piecing template or plastic template material
- Paper
- Sewline glue pen
- Size No. 8 straw needle
- Serrated scissors
- Thread
- Basic sewing tools and supplies

# Butterfly Tree Wall Hanging

### Materials

- Small pieces repeatable prints and coordinating tonals or prints
- · Scraps medium green tonal
- Scraps or 1 fat eighth each light and dark green tonals
- 1 fat quarter medium brown tonal
- 1/3 yard green tonal
- ½ yard coordinating print
- 11/8 yards blue tonal
- Backing to size
- Batting to size
- Approximately 250 (¾") hexagon English paper-piecing papers
- Purchased paper-piecing template or plastic template material
- Paper
- Sewline glue pen
- Size No. 8 straw needle
- Serrated scissors
- Thread
- Basic sewing tools and supplies
