## MATERIALS LIST

### Scrappy Sew-and- Flip Table Topper



#### Materials

- Fat quarters or large scraps of 10 different fabrics to total 2 yards
- 1½ yards white solid
- Batting 30" x 30"
- Thread
- Basic sewing tools and supplies

### Courthouse Steps Pot Holder

#### Materials

- Scraps light, medium and dark blue batik
- Scraps light, medium and dark green batik
- ⅛ yard blue-green batik
- 9" square backing
- 9" square needle-punched insulated batting
- 9" square silver ironing board cover fabric
- Thread
- Basic sewing tools and supplies



### French Braid Table Runner

#### Materials

- Scraps or precut strips 9 different medium to dark tonal batiks
- Scraps 9 different light batiks
- ¾ yard tan batik
- 1¼ yards backing
- 40" square batting
- Thread
- Basic sewing tools and supplies



### Baby Love Appliqué Quilt

#### Materials

- ½ yard dark pink tonal
- ⅔ yard light pink tonal
- 1⅞ yards white tonal
- 1½ yards backing
- 42" x 45" rectangle batting
- 2 yards paper-backed fusible web
- Appliqué pressing sheet
- Thread
- Basic sewing tools and supplies



### Turquoise Bliss Quilt

#### Materials

- ¾ yard purple batik
- 1 yard turquoise batik
- 1⅔ yards blue batik
- 1⅞ yards white solid
- 3½ yards backing
- 1½ yards 96-inch-wide batting
- Thread to match backing and border fabric
- Basic sewing tools and supplies
