Materials

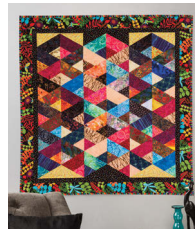
- 20 assorted 2½" x 30" strips
- 20 assorted scraps at least 3½" square
- ½ yard coordinating tonal for binding
- Backing to size
- Batting to size
- Thread
- Basic sewing tools and supplies



Paradise Dream

Materials

- Assortment of 10 light 3" x 22" strips cut from scraps
- Assortment of 15 dark 3" x 22" strips cut from scraps
- ¼ yard accent fabric
- ½ yard sashing fabric
- 1 yard border and binding fabric
- Polygon Tool (optional)
- Polygon2 Tool (optional)
- Backing to size
- Batting to size
- Thread
- Basic sewing tools and supplies



Arrowhead Star Quilt With Pieced Border

Materials

- 35 (1¾" x 22") strips assorted prints
- 35 (1¾" x 22") strips assorted solids
- 90 (3") B squares pieced border assorted solids coordinating with block fabrics
- ⅞ yard tonal for binding
- 1⅞ yards print for cornerstones and triangles
- 1¼ yards print for sashing
- 1¼ yards pieced border print
- 1½ yards float border print
- 2 yards block background solid
- 2 yards block border print
- Backing to size
- Batting to size
- Thread
- Basic sewing tools and supplies
