

# Learn to Piece Scrappy Borders

## MATERIALS LIST

### Split Churn Dash With Serpentine Border

#### Materials

- 6 fat eighths of light prints (background)\*: label 4 as A
- 12 fat eighths of medium to dark print\*: label 4 as B
- 1 fat eighth each of orange, lime, teal and pink tonals\*
- 1 yard orange tonal (binding)\*
- 3½ yards white solid
- Backing to size
- Batting to size\*
- Thread\*
- Basic sewing tools and supplies

\*Wild by Nature from Maywood Studios, Bamboo batting from Winline and Aurifil Thread was used to make the sample quilt.



### Split Churn Dash With Braid Border

#### Materials

- 2 (6" x 44") precut strip packs for a total of 40 pieces\*
- 1 yard blue print batik\*
- Backing to size
- Batting to size\*
- Thread\*
- Basic sewing tools and supplies

\*Happy Hour Batiks from Timeless Treasures, Bamboo batting from Winline and Aurifil Thread was used to make the sample quilt.

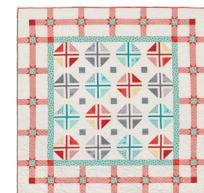


### Split Churn Dash With Star Anchor Border

#### Materials

- 12 fat eighths of assorted prints in 3 colors of red, gray & aqua\*: label as B
- 1 fat eighth gray print\*
- 1 fat eighth each of gray, teal and red solid
- ½ yard aqua print\*
- 1 yard red print
- 1 yard red tonal (¾ yard will be used for binding, ¼ yard will be used for Star points)
- 3½ yards white solid
- Backing to size
- Batting to size\*
- Thread\*
- Basic sewing tools and supplies

\*Dominicana from Timeless Treasures, Bamboo batting from Winline and Aurifil Thread was used to make the sample quilt.



### Split Churn Dash With Sawtooth Border

#### Materials

- 4 fat eighths of light prints\*: label as A
- 9 fat eighths of medium to dark prints\*: label as B
- 3 fat eighths of assorted solids\*
- 1 fat eighth of yellow solid
- 1 yard light blue solid (binding)\*
- 2¾ yards white solid
- Backing to size
- Batting to size\*
- Thread\*
- Basic sewing tools and supplies

\*Animal Quackers from Maywood Studios, Bamboo batting from Winline and Aurifil Thread was used to make the sample quilt.
