Tumbling Blocks Bed Runner

Materials

- $\frac{1}{2}$ [$\frac{5}{8}$] yard
pumpkin
tonal*
- $\frac{2}{3}$ [$\frac{3}{4}$] yard
emerald tonal*
- $2\frac{1}{3}$ [$2\frac{1}{3}$] yards
berry tonal*
- $2\frac{1}{4}$ [$2\frac{1}{3}$] yards gray tonal*
- Backing to size*
- Batting to size*
- 60-degree ruler
- Thread
- Basic sewing tools and supplies

- $4\frac{2}{3}$ yards white
solid*
- $5\frac{1}{4}$ yards blue
dot*
- Backing to
size*
- Batting to size*
- Paper-backed fusible web*
- Thread
