MATERIALS LIST

Pot Holder

Materials

- 1 each red, orange and blue fat guarter*
- ¹/₂ yard lightweight fusible interfacing
- ½ yard cotton batting
- ¹⁄₄ yard needle-punched insulated batting
- Walking or even-feed sewing machine presser foot
- Thread to match*
- Basic sewing supplies and equipment

Ruffled Shopping Tote

Materials

- 1 fat guarter each floral and stripe*
- 2 red fat quarters*
- 3 polka-dot fat quarters*
- 2 yards lightweight fusible interfacing
- Thread to match*
- Turn-It-All[™] turning tool (optional)
- Basic sewing supplies and equipment

Table Runner

Materials

- Scraps, approximately 4 inches square, red floral, stripe and green*
- ½ yard agua solid*
- ⁷/₈ yard red dots*
- ¼ yard paper-backed fusible web or 1 (9 x 12-inch) sheet*
- 1³/₈ yards lightweight fusible interfacing
- Thread to match*
- 6 (%-inch) white buttons
- Basic sewing supplies and equipment

Place Mat

Materials

- Fat quarters* 1 aqua 2 red dots
- ½ yard lightweight fusible interfacing
- Thread to match*
- For optional appliqué:
 - Scraps, approximately 4 inches square, red floral, stripe and green Scraps paper-backed fusible web 3 (5%-inch) white buttons
- Basic sewing supplies and equipment



Napkin Ring & Napkin

Materials

- Blue with cream and cream with blue remnants*
- 1 fat quarter orange*
- ¹/₈ yard lightweight fusible interfacing •
- Thread to match*
- 1 large (%–1-inch) button •
- Basic sewing supplies and equipment •

Coupon **Organizer**

Materials

- 1 fat quarter each* small red floral small orange floral blue petals
- ²/₃ yard lightweight fusible interfacing
- Zipper foot
- Thread to match*
- 1 package ¹/₂-inch-wide white rickrack
- 1 (9-inch) nylon zipper
- Basic sewing supplies and equipment







Sewing Beyond the Basics: Kitchen Accessories

MATERIALS LIST

Oven Mitt

Materials

- 1 fat quarter each blue doily and blue petals *
- 1 fat quarter red doily (optional if using purchased bias binding)*
- 1/2 yard muslin
- 1/2 yard lightweight fusible interfacing
- ¹/₂ yard cotton batting
- ½ yard needle-punched insulated batting
- Thread to match*
- 1 yard ½-inch-wide coordinating rickrack
- 1 package ½-inch-wide double- fold red bias tape (optional if making binding)
- Walking or even-feed presser foot
- Basic sewing supplies and equipment



• 1 fat quarter

each* blue butterfly small blue floral green butterfly small red floral

- ½ yard cotton batting
- ½ yard muslin
- ½ yard lightweight fusible interfacing
- Thread to match*
- 1 package ½-inch-wide, double-fold red bias tape
- Walking or even-feed sewing machine presser foot
- Turn-It-All[™] turning tool (optional)
- Basic sewing supplies and equipment
