Cinnamon Roll Pincushion

Materials

- Scrap white fleece
- ¼ yard brown dot*
- 1 ceramic dessert dish
- Polyester fiberfill
- Thread
- White craft glue
- Basic sewing supplies and equipment

Floral Fiesta Table Runner

Materials

- ¼ yard each coordinating teal, orange, green and salmon solid*
- ⅝ yard floral print*
- 1½ yards brown solid*
- Thread
- Basic sewing supplies and equipment

Yo-Yo Baby Bib

Materials

- ¼ yard multicolored print*
- ¼ yard teal dot*
- ⅓ yard teal solid for backing
- ½-inch x 1-inch strip hook-and-loop tape
- Thread
- Yo-Yo Maker*
- Basic sewing supplies and equipment

Posies & Pocket Apron

Materials

- Scrap teal solid*
- ¼ yard orange solid*
- ¾ yard floral print*
- 1 (⅞-inch) teal button
- Thread
- Basic sewing supplies and equipment

Baking Dish Carrier

Materials

- ⅔ yard pre-quilted muslin with cotton batting
- ½ yard each green floral print and green tonal*
- Heat-resistant batting
- Cotton batting
- 40 inches white 1-inch-wide cotton web
- 10 inches 1-inch-wide hook-and-loop tape
- Thread
- Basic sewing supplies and equipment
