Basic Sock on Two Circular Needles (page 10)
Heel
Knit 16 (20, 24). Turn. Arrange sts for working heel, with 16 (20, $24)$ sts on heel flap and $16(20,24)$ sts on instep. Work back and forth in rows on heel sts only.

Knit $16(20,24)$ stitches and turn. Your front ... reset the stitches.
Basic Sock on One Long Circular Needles (page 14)

## Heel

Knit $16(20,24)$. Turn. Arrange sts for working heel, with 16 (20, $24)$ sts on heel flap and $16(20,24)$ sts on instep. Work back and forth in rows on heel sts only.

Knit $16(20,24)$ stitches and turn. The front ... reset the stitches.
