Knit 16 (20, 24). Turn. Arrange sts for working heel, with 16 (20, 24) sts on heel flap and 16 (20, 24) sts on instep. Work back and forth in rows on heel sts only.

Knit 16 (20, 24) stitches and turn. Your front ... reset the stitches.

Basic Sock on One Long Circular Needles (page 14) Heel

Knit 16 (20, 24). Turn. Arrange sts for working heel, with 16 (20, 24) sts on heel flap and 16 (20, 24) sts on instep. Work back and forth in rows on heel sts only.

Knit 16 (20, 24) *stitches and turn. The front ... reset the stitches.*


