A: With size G hook amethyst, join with sc in next marked st, sk next st, ( 3 dc , ch $1,3 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in next st, sk next st, sc in each of next 2 sts, turn. (9 sts, 1 ch sp)
B: 3 dc in 2 nd dc of next $3-\mathrm{dc}$ group, ch $1,3 \mathrm{dc}$ in next ch sp , ch $1,3 \mathrm{dc}$ in 2 nd dc of next 3 -dc group, sk next st on rnd 1 of 4 th Section, sc in each of next 3 sts, turn. (3 dc groups, 2 ch sps)
C: Work 3 dc in 2 nd dc of each 3-dc group and in each ch sp across, sk next st on rnd 1 of 4th Section, sl st in next st. Fasten off. (15dc)
D: [Rep steps A-C consecutively] 31 times for a total of 32 Half Circles
