Row 4: Work in Pattern across to last cl, [ch 1, sk next st, dc in next st] across to last dc and beg 3 sk chs of turning ch-6, ch 1, sk next st, (dc, ch 3, dc, ch 1, dc) in 3rd ch of turning ch-6, turn. (31 [31, 51, 51, 71, 71] sts and chs)

## Armhole Shaping

Row [9]: Work in Pattern across to last 6 sts, ch 1, sk next ch, dc dec in first and last of next 3 sts, dc in next st, leaving rem st unworked, turn. ([35,55, 75] sts and chs)
(2/17/10-st/mjl)
SLEEVE
2X-Large Size Only (page 10)
Rows [23-28]: Rep rows [10-15].
Rows [29 \& 30]: Work in Pattern across. Fasten off at end of last row.
(4/1/08 maf)
RIGHT FRONT (page 6)
Row 3: Ch 6, dc in 4th ch from hook (beg 3 sk chs count as first dc), dc in each st to last 2 sts before next cl, cl, work in Pattern across rem sts, turn. ( $26[26,46,46,66,66]$ sts and chs)
Row 4: Work in Pattern across to last cl , [ch 1, sk next st, dc in next st] across to last dc and beg 3 sk chs of turning ch-6, ch 1 , sk next st, (dc, ch 3, dc, ch 1, dc) in 3rd ch of turning ch-6, turn. (31 [31, 51, 51, 71, 71] sts and chs)

Row [2]: Work in Pattern across to last 3 sts, sc dec in next 2 sts, dc in last st, turn. ([25, 27, 31, 33] sts)
Row [3]: Ch 3 (see Pattern Notes), sc dec in next 2 sts, work in Pattern across, turn. ([24, 26, 30, 32] sts)

Row 5: Ch 4, *sc in next ch-3 sp, shell in next ch-5 sp, sc in next ch-3 sp**, ch 3 , rep from * across, ending last rep at **, ch 1 , dc in last st, turn. (2 [2, 2, 3, 2, 3] shells)
Row 22 [22, 22, 26, 26, 30]: Ch 6 , sc in same st, ch $3, *(d c$, ch $5, \mathrm{dc})$ in 2 nd ch of next ch- 3 sp , ch 3 , sc in center dc of next shell, ch 3 , rep from * across to last st, (dc, ch 3, dc) in last st, turn. (2 [2, 2, 3, 2, 3] ch-5 sps)
Row 28 [28, 28, 32, 32, 36]: Ch 6, sc in first st, *ch 3, (dc, ch 5, dc) in 2 nd ch of next ch-3 sp, ch $3^{* *}$, sc in 6th st of next shell, rep from * across, ending last rep at ${ }^{* *}$, sc in last st, turn. (3 [3, 3, 4, 3, 4] ch-5 sps)
Row 30 [30, 30, 34, 34, 38]: Ch 6 , sc in same st, ch 3, [(dc, ch 5 , dc) in center ch of next ch-3 sp, ch 3, sc in 6th st of next shell, ch 3] across to last st, (dc, ch 3, dc) in last st, turn. (3 [3, 3, 4, 3, 4] ch-5 sps)

## BODY (page 39)

Row 1: Working across Left Front, join in first st, ch $3,5 \mathrm{dc}$ in next ch-3 sp, *sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3 , sc in next ch-3 sp, shell in next ch-5 sp, rep from * across to last 3 ch- 3 sps , sc in next ch- 3 sp , ch 3 , sc in next ch- $3 \mathrm{sp}, 5 \mathrm{dc}$ in next ch- 3 sp , dc in last st, for armhole, ch $46[46,46,46,70,70]$, working across last row of Back, dc in first st, 5 dc in next ch- $3 \mathrm{sp},{ }^{*} \mathrm{sc}$ in next ch- 3 sp , ch 3 , sc in next ch- 3 sp, shell in next ch- 5 sp , rep from * across to last $3 \mathrm{ch}-3 \mathrm{sps}$, sc in next ch- 3 sp , ch 3 , sc in next ch- $3 \mathrm{sp}, 5 \mathrm{dc}$ in next ch- 3 sp , dc in last st, for armhole, ch 46 [ $46,46,46,70,70]$, working across last row of Right Front, dc in first st, shell in next ch- 3 sp, *sc in next ch- 3 sp , ch 3 , sc in next ch- 3 sp , shell in next ch-5 sp, rep from * across to last $3 \mathrm{ch}-3 \mathrm{sps}$, sc in next ch- 3 sp , ch 3 , sc in next ch- $3 \mathrm{sp}, 5 \mathrm{dc}$ in next ch-3 sp, dc in last st, turn.
Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first st, *ch 3, (dc, ch 5, dc) in 2nd ch of next ch-3 sp, ch 3, [sc in 6th dc of next shell, ch 3, (dc, ch 5, dc) in 2 nd ch of next ch-3 sp] across to next 6 -dc group, dc in last st**, ch 3 , sk next 5 chs on armhole, (dc, ch 5 , dc) in next ch, ch 3 , sk next 5 chs, [sc in next ch, ch 3 , sk next 5 chs, (dc, ch 5 , dc) in next ch, ch 3 , sk next 5 chs] across, sc in next st, rep from * across ending last rep at **, turn. ( 22 [23, 26, 27, 30, 31] ch-5 sps)
Row 5: Ch 3,5 dc in next ch- 3 sp , ${ }^{\text {sc }}$ in next ch- 3 sp , ch 3 , sc in next ch- $3 \mathrm{sp} * *$, shell in next ch- 5 sp, rep from * across, ending last rep at ${ }^{* *}$, 5 dc in last ch-3 sp, dc in last st, turn. (21 [22, 25, 26, 29, 30] shells)

## SLEEVES

Row 1: With RS facing, join yarn in st at bottom of 1 armhole before side of bodice, working in ends of rows of bodice, 6 dc in first row, *sk next row, sc in next row, ch 3 , sk next row, sc in next row, sk next row**, shell in next row, rep from * across, ending last rep at ${ }^{* *}, 6 \mathrm{sc}$ in next row, sl st in st on opposite side of armhole ch, turn. ( $8[9,10,11,12,12]$ shells)
Rnd $17[17,17,17,21,21]$ : Now working in rnds, ch $3,5 \mathrm{dc}$ in first ch-3 sp, ${ }^{\text {sc }} \mathrm{sc}$ in next ch- 3 sp , ch 3 , sc in next ch- $3 \mathrm{sp} * *$, shell in next ch- 5 sp , rep from * across, ending last rep at ${ }^{* *}, 5 \mathrm{dc}$ in last ch sp , dc in last st, join in 3 rd ch of beg ch-3, turn. (8 [9, 10, 11, 12, 12] shells)
Rnd 21 [21, 21, 21, 25, 25]: Ch $3,5 \mathrm{dc}$ in same sp , ${ }^{*} \mathrm{sc}$ in next ch-3 sp, ch 3 , sc in next ch- $3 \mathrm{sp}{ }^{* *}$, shell in next ch- 5 sp , rep from * across, ending last rep at ${ }^{* *}$, 5 dc in next ch-3 sp, ch-3, sl st in 3 rd ch of beg ch-3, turn. ( 8 [9,10,11, 12, 12] shells)
