Rnd 6 (joining rnd): Join jade in center ch-3 sp of any petal of rnd 5, beg dc cl in same sp as join, ch 2 , sc in center ch-3 sp of any petal on previous Motif, ch 2, 2 -dc cl in same ch-3 sp on current motif, ch 4 , sc in next ch-8 sp on previous Motif, ch $4,2-\mathrm{dc} \mathrm{cl}$ in center ch-3 sp of next petal, ch 2, sc in center ch-3 sp of next petal on previous Motif, $2-\mathrm{dc} \mathrm{cl}$ in same center ch-3 sp on previous Motif, ch 8 , [(2-dc cl, ch $5,2-\mathrm{dc} \mathrm{cl})$ in center ch-3 sp of next petal, ch 8] around, join in top of beg cl. Fasten off.

Rnd 21: Ch $3,4 \mathrm{dc}$ in same ch as beg ch-3, sc in next dc, 5 dc in next dc, sc in next dc, * ch 3, sk next ch-3 sp, 5 tr in next ch sp of pineapple, ch 3 , sc in next dc ${ }^{* *}$, [ 5 dc in next dc, sc in next dc] 3 times, rep from * around, ending last rep at ${ }^{* *}, 5 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, sc in last dc, join in top of beg ch-3.
Rnd 22: Ch 2 , dc dec in next 4 sts, ch 5 , sl st in next sc, ch 5 , dc dec in next 5 sts, ch 5 , sl st in next sc, ${ }^{*}$ ch 7 , tr dec (see Stitch Guide) in next 5 sts, ch 7 , sl st in next sc ${ }^{* *}$, [ch 5 , dc dec in next 5 sts, ch 5 , sl st in next sc] 3 times, rep from $*$ around, ending last rep at $* *$, ch 5 , dc dec in next 5 sts, sl st in last sc, ch 5 , join in top of first dc dec.

Delete all text from Assembly heading on (pages 57-59). Replace with the following instructions: OUTER MOTIF BRUGES LACE EDGING
Work Outer Motif Bruges Lace Edging the same as Center Motif Bruges Lace Edging. There are $5 \mathrm{ch}-5 \mathrm{sps}$ on each of the 6 sides of the Center Motif Bruges Lace Edging (between row-4 repeats). Join motifs on 1, 2, 3 or 4 sides as you work, substituting [ch 2, sc in corresponding ch-5 sp on adjacent motif, ch 2] for the ch-5 sp on the working motif.
Following the Assembly Diagram, join the first Maize Motif to the Center Motif on 1 side (even-numbered rows 44-52). Join the 2nd-5th Maize Motifs to the Center Motif and to the previous Maize Motif on 2 sides (even-numbered rows 34-52). When joining the 6th Maize Motif to the 5th Maize Motif, the Center Motif and the first Maize Motif, join on 3 sides (even-numbered rows 24-52).
In the same manner, join Orchid Pink Motifs to Maize Motifs and to adjacent Orchid Pink Motifs; join Wood Violet Motifs to Orchid Pink Motifs and to adjacent Wood Violet Motifs. Note: The 12th Orchid Pink Motif and the 18th Wood Violet Motif will be joined on 4 sides.

## OUTER MOTIF BRUGES LACE EDGING

Work Outer Motif Bruges Lace Edging the same as Center Motif Bruges Lace Edging. There are $5 \mathrm{ch}-5 \mathrm{sps}$ on each of the 6 sides of the Center Motif Bruges Lace Edging (between row-4 repeats). Join motifs on 1, 2 or 3 sides as you work, substituting [ch 2, sc in corresponding ch-5 sp on adjacent motif, ch 2] for the ch-5 sp on the working motif.
Join the first Wood Violet Motif to the Center Motif on 1 side (even-numbered rows 44-52). Join the 2nd-5th Wood Violet Motifs to the Center Motif and to the previous Wood Violet Motifs on 2 sides (even-numbered rows 34-52). When joining the 6th Wood Violet Motif to the 5th Wood Violet Motif, the Center Motif and the first Wood Violet Motif, join on 3 sides (even-numbered rows 24-52).

( $16 \mathrm{sc}, 12$ ch sps, 8 shells)
Rnd 8: Ch 8 , *sk next sc, sc in each of next 2 sts, ch 5 , shell in first dc of next shell, ch 3 , sk next 3 sts, dc in next st, ch 3 , sk next ch sp, ch 3 , sk next ch sp, dc in next st, ch 3 , sk next ch sp, ( $3 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 3,3 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in next ch sp, [ch 3, sk next ch sp, dc in next dc] twice, ch 3 , sk next 3 sts**, shell in next st, ch 5 , rep from * around, ending last rep at ${ }^{* *}, 4 \mathrm{dc}$ in same st as beg ch- 8 , join in 3 rd ch of beg ch- 8 . ( $40 \mathrm{dc}, 8$ shells)

Row 8: Ch 4,2 tr in same st as beg ch, tr in each of next 6 tr , ch 1 , sk ... .
Row 11: Ch 2 , sl st in same tr ... tr in each of next $6 \mathrm{tr}, 3 \mathrm{tr}$ in next tr, turn. (18 tr)

Rnd 3: Sl st in each st across to next (delete: to) ch-1 sp, sl st in ch-1 sp, beg shell in same ch-1 sp as last sl st , sk next ch sp , [shell in next ch sp ,
sk next ch sp] around, join in top of beg ch-3. (8 shells)

Row 2: Ch 3 (see Pattern Notes), dc in next dc, [ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc] 9 times, dc in next dc, turn. (12 dc)
Rows 3 \& 4: Ch 3, dc in next dc, [ch 1, dc in next dc] 9 times, dc in next dc, turn.
Rnds 7-12: Ch 3, dc in next dc, [ch 1, dc in next dc] 9 times, dc in next dc, ch 2 , dc in each of next 6 dc, ch 2 , dc in each of next 2 dc, [ch 1 , dc in next dc] 9 times, dc in next dc, ch 2, dc in each of next 6 dc , ch 2 , join in 3 rd ch of beg ch-3.

Rnd 4: Sl st in next ch-2 sp, ch 2 (counts as hdc), hdc in same ch-2 sp, ... .
DISPLAY DOILY (page 96)
Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in same st as beg ch-1, * ... ch 1, hdc in first sc to position hook in center of last ch sp to beg following rnd, turn. (12 sc, 12 ch sps)
Rnd 3: Sc in ch sp just made, ... .
Rnd 4: Sc in ch sp just made, ... .
Rnd 5: Sc in ch sp just made, ... .
Rnd 6: Beg V-st (see Special Stitches) in same sp, ch 5, ... .
Rnd 8: Sl st across to center of beg V-st, ... V-st in 2nd ch of ch-3 sp of next V-st, rep from * around, ch 5, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-5.
Rnd 11: Sl st across to center of beg V-st, ch 7, V-st in 2nd ch of ch-3 sp of next V-st, rep from * around, ch 7, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-5.
Rnd 14: Sl st across to center of beg V-st, ... ch 9, V-st in 2nd ch of ch-3 sp of next V-st, rep from * around, ch 9, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-5.
Rnd 22: Sl st across to center of beg V -st, ... tr V -st in 12th ch of next ch sp , tr V -st in center of next V -st, rep from * around, join in rth ch of beg ch-6.
Rnd 23: Ch 4, *sk ch sp ... rep from * around, tr in next st, ch 3, join (delete: to) in top of ch-4.
