Work Outer Motif Bruges Lace Edging the same as Center Motif Bruges Lace Edging. There are 5 ch-5 sps on each of the 6 sides of the Center Motif Bruges Lace Edging (between row-4 repeats). Join motifs on 1, 2, 3 or 4 sides as you work, substituting [ch 2, sc in corresponding ch-5 sp on adjacent motif, ch 2] for the ch-5 sp on the working motif.

Following the Assembly Diagram, join the first Maize Motif to the Center Motif on 1 side (even-numbered rows 44–52). Join the 2nd–5th Maize Motifs to the Center Motif and to the previous Maize Motif on 2 sides (even-numbered rows 34–52). When joining the 6th Maize Motif to the 5th Maize Motif, the Center Motif and the first Maize Motif, join on 3 sides (even-numbered rows 24–52).
