Next Row: P7 (6, 6, 7, 6, 6, 5), M1 (see Special Abbreviations); * P14 (8, 9, 9, 10, 11, 9), M1; rep from * $0(4,4,4,4,4,6)$ times more; $\mathrm{P} 7(6,5,6,6,5,4)-30(58,62,64,68,72,76)$ sts.

Left Front
Neck Shaping:
Work rows $1-3$ as written.
Rows 4 through $7(13,13,13,13,15,13)$ : Work as written
Next Row: Knit.
Next Row: Purl.
Rep last 2 rows until piece measures about $6^{\prime \prime}\left(14 \frac{1}{2} ", 151 / 2^{\prime \prime}, 171 / 2^{\prime \prime}, 19^{1 / 2 "}, 21\right.$ ", $23^{\prime \prime}$ ) from cast-on edge, ending by working a wrong side row.
Bind off.
Right Front
Neck Shaping:
Work rows 1-4 as written.
Rows 5 through $8(14,14,14,14,16,14)$ :Work as written.
Next Row: Knit.
Next Row: Purl.
Rep last two rows until piece measures about $6^{\prime \prime}\left(14^{1} 2^{\prime \prime}, 15^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}, 171 / 2^{\prime \prime}, 191 / 2^{\prime \prime}, 21\right.$ ", $22^{1} 1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) from cast-on edge, ending by working a wrong side row.
Bind off.

Row 12: P7 (8, 8, 4, 4, 4), M1 (see Special Abbreviations on page 17); * P14 (15, 16, 8, 8, 8), M1; rep from * $0(0,0,2,2,2)$ times more; P7 (7, 8, 4, 4, 4)-30 (32, 34, 36, 36, 36) sts.

## Hood

Note: For Sizes 2, 4, 6, 8 and 10 only change to larger size needles.
Row 1 (wrong side): Work as written.

Back (page 24)
With larger size needles, cast on $163(173,183,193,213,223)$ sts.
(1/15/08)
Pretty Pink Tunic (for doll)
(Page 21)
Gauge: 5 sts and 7 rows $=1 "$
Back (page 22)
With smaller size needles, cast on 83 sts.

## Ruffle Border:

Rows 11 and 12: Rep Rows 9 and 10.
Change to larger size needles.

## Front

Continue in pattern as established until piece measures about 7 " from cast-on edge, ending by working a Row 8.
Sleeve (make 2)
With smaller size needles, cast on 24 sts.
Border:
Row 4: K6, M1 (see Special Abbreviations); *K6, M1; rep from * once more: K6—27 sts.
Change to larger size needles.
DELETE: Continue in pattern inc one st each end every 4th row once more-- 37 sts.

## Instructions

Back (Page 24)
With smaller size needles, cast on $163,(173,183,193,213,223)$ sts.
Ruffle Border:
Row 12: P3; * sl next 2 sts as to knit, K1, P2SSO; P3; rep from * across-67(71, 75, 79, 87, 91) sts.
Body:
Row 6: K4 (6, 4, 6, 6, 4); * K2 tog, YO; K1, YO; SSK; K3; rep from * $6(6,7,7,8,9)$ times more; K2 tog; YO; K1, YO; SSK; K2 (4, $2,4,4,2$ ). Making this change should place the YOs on Row 6 on either side of the YO on Row 4.
Row 16: Rep Row 12.

Row 8: P7 (9, 9, 9, 7, 10), mock cable; * P4, mock cable; rep from * $5(5,6,7,8,8)$ times more; P7 $(9,9,9,7,10)$.
Row 9: K7 (9, 9, 7, 10), P3, *K4, P3; rep from * $5(5,6,7,8,8)$ times more; P7 (9, 9, 9, 7, 10).

## Ribbing:

## Rows 2 through 15: Rep Row 1.

Row 16: Continuing in pattern as established, work $6(6,6,4,8,6)$ sts, M1 (see Special Abbreviations); *work $10(11,8,9,9,10)$ sts, M1; rep from * $4(4,6,6,6,6)$ times more; work $6(5,6,5,7,6)$ sts- $68(72,76,80,86,90)$ sts.
Armhole Shaping:
Rows 7 through 14: With red, rep Rows 5 and 6 four times more. At end of Row $14-44(48,52,56,60,62)$ sts.
Rows 15 through $38(40,44,48,48,50)$ : With black, rep Rows 5 and 6 twelve ( $13,15,17,17,18$ ) times. At end of last row-20 (22, $22,22,26,26)$ sts.
Row 39 (41, 45, 49, 49, 51): Knit.
Row 40 (42, 46, 50, 50, 52): Purl.
Bind off.

## Front

Armhole Shaping: (page 35)
Rows 7 through 14: With red, rep Rows 5 and 6 four times. At end of Row $14-44(48,52,56,60,62)$ sts.
Rows 15 through $20(\mathbf{2 0}, \mathbf{2 2}, \mathbf{2 4}, \mathbf{2 8}, \mathbf{2 8})$ : With black, rep Rows 5 and 6 three ( $3,4,5,7,7$ ) times more. At end of last row- 38 (42, $44,46,46,48)$ sts.

## Neck Shaping:

Rows 5 through $10(\mathbf{1 0 , 1 0 , 1 0 , 1 2 , 1 2 ) : ~ R e p ~ R o w s ~} 3$ and 4 three ( $3,3,3,4,4$ ) times more. At end of last row-5 $(7,7,8,5,6)$ sts.
Row 11 (11, 11, 11, 13, 13): For left shoulder, K2 SSK; knit across; for right shoulder, knit to last 4 sts; K2tog, K2 -- 4 (6, 6, 7, 4, 5) sts.
Row 12 (12, 12, 12, 14 , 14): Purl.
Rep last two rows until 1 st remains.
Finish off.
Sleeve (make 2) (page 35)
Body:
Row 8: Purl
Continue working in stockinette stitch (knit one row, purl one row) inc one st each end every 5 th ( 6 th, 6 th, 6 th, 6 th, 6 th) row 8 ( 8,9 , $10,10,13)$ times more-54 $(56,60,64,66,70)$ sts while working in the following color sequence:
Note: When increases have been completed work even (without increases), in stockinette st.
$14(22,26,34,44,48)$ rows black, including first 8 rows of body
5 rows white
8 rows black
5 rows white
8 rows black
5 rows white
7 rows black.
Sleeve Cap Shaping: (page 35)
Continue in stockinette st with black, dec at each end of every other row $9(10,12,14,14,15)$ times more; then dec at beg and end of every 3rd row twice. At end of last dec row--6 sts.
Bind off.

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## Cool Blue Gansey

Product Code W1348, Page Number 36
(2/25/05)
Cool Blue Gansey (for doll)
Sleeve (page 37)
Row 16: K1, SSK; knit to last 3 sts; K2 tog; K1--20 sts.
Row 17: Purl.
Row 18: Knit.
Rows 19 through 24: Rep Rows 13 through 18 once more. At end of Row 24-18 sts.
Rep Rows 13 and 14 until sleeve measures about 3 3/4", ending by working a wrong side row.
Next Row: K5, K2 tog; K4, K2 tog; K5-16 sts.
Change to smaller size needles.
Cool Blue Gansey (for child)
Sleeve (page 40)
Row 8: K2, SSK; K1; * P2, K2; rep from * to last 7 sts; P2; K1, K2 tog; K2--50 (54, 58, 62, 66, 70) sts
Row 16: K2, SSK, P1; * K2, P2; rep from * to last 7 sts; K2, P1, K2 tog; K2--46 (50, 54, 58, 62, 66) sts.

For Doll Size Only:
Rep Rows 31 and 32 until sleeve measures about 4 inches, ending by working a wrong side row.

Ribbing:
Rep Row 1 until ribbing measures about $1 / 2(2,2,2,2,2,2)$ inches, ending by working a wrong side row.
