(15 [16, 17, 19] half flowers) Row 2: Ch 4, dc in next ch-3 sp; \*ch 1, in top of next half flower work [cl (see Special Stitches), ch 3, cl]; ch 1, dc dec (see page 25) in next 2 ch-3 sps; rep from \* to last half flower; ch 1, in top of last half flower work (cl, ch 3, cl); ch 1, yo, draw up lp in sp formed by 2 sk chs of ch-5 sp, yo, draw through 2 lps on hook; yo twice, yo, draw up lp in same sp, [yo, draw through 2 lps on hook] twice; yo and draw through all 3 lps on hook, turn. Row 3: Ch 3, yo, draw up lp in first st, yo, draw through 2 lps on hook; half cl in top of next cl; yo and draw through all 5 lps on hook; \*ch 3, cl in top of st just made; ch 3, sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 5, half cl in 3rd ch from hook and in each of next 2 cls; yo and draw through all 10 lps on hook--half flower made; ch 3, cl in top of half flower just made; ch 3, sc in next ch-3 sp; rep from \* across; ch 5, half cl in 3rd ch from hook and in next cl; yo, draw

up lp in next dc; yo and draw through all 8 lps on hook, turn. Row 4: Ch 4, cl in first st; \*ch 1, dc dec in next 2 ch-3 sps; ch 1, in top of next half flower work (cl, ch 3, cl); rep from \* across to sp formed by 2 sk chs of last ch-5; ch 1, dc dec in sp formed by sk chs and next ch-3 sp; ch 1, in last st work (cl, ch 1, dc), turn.

**Row 8:** Ch 3, dc in each of next 4 sc, ch 1, [sk next 2 sc, 3 dc in next sc] 3 times; ch 1, sk next 2 sc, dc in each of last 4 sc, turn.

Row 10: Ch 4 (counts as a dc and a ch-1 sp on this and following rows), [sk next 3 sc, 3 dc in next sc] 4 times; ch 1, sk next 2 sc, dc in last sc, turn.

**Row 12:** Ch 3, dc in each of next 3 sc, ch 1, [sk next 2 sc, 3 dc in next sc] 3 times; ch 1, sk next 2 sc, dc in each of last 4 sc, turn.

**Row 14:** Ch 3, dc in each of next 6 sc, ch 1, sk next 2 sc, 3 dc in next sc; ch 1, sk next 2 sc, dc in each of last 7 sc, turn.

**Row 16:** Ch 3, dc in each of next 7 sc, ch 1, sk next sc, dc in next sc, ch 1, sk next sc, dc in each of last 8 sc, turn.

Row 19: Ch 1, sc in each dc across, turn. Rows 20–163: [Work rows 4–19] 9 times.
