**Row 2:** Ch 3 (*counts as first dc throughout*), [**dc dec** (*see Stitch Guide*) in first and last dc (skipping center dc and picot) of picot shell, ch 3, sc over next ch-3 sp] across, turn.

# Afghan

**Row 3:** Working in **back lps** (see Stitch Guide) only, attach peach with sl st in first hdc, ch 3, dc in next hdc, [ch 2, **dc dec** (see Stitch Guide) in next 3 sts] across to 3rd st from end, ch 2 work first leg of dc dec as usual, sk next hdc only, finish same dc dec in top of end ch, ch 2, drop peach, do not turn. (42 ch-2 sps)

# Afghan

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in first dc, sc in next ch sp of shell, sc shell in ch sp of each of next 5 shells, \*(sc shell, ch 3, sc shell) in next ch-3 sp, sc shell in each of next 4 shells, sc in each of next 2 ch sps of shells, sc shell in ch sp of each of next 4 shells, rep from \* to within last ch-3 sp, (sc shell, ch 3, sc shell) in last ch-3 sp, sc shell in ch sp of each of next 5 shells, sc in next ch sp, dc in last sc, turn.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in first st, dc in next st, [sc in next st, dc in next st] across, turn.

## Afghan

**Row 1 (RS):** With buff, ch 149, dc in 6th ch from hook, \*[ch 1, sk 1 ch, dc in next ch] 3 times, sk next 3 chs \*\*, 5 dc in next ch, ch 2, dc in next ch, rep from \* across, ending last rep at \*\*, 4 dc in 2nd ch from end, dc in last ch, turn.

# (11/10/05 mdm)

## Afghan

**Row 2:** Ch 5 (*counts as first dc*, *ch 2 throughout*), dc in base of ch-5, \*[ch 1, sk 1 dc, dc in next dc] twice, ch 1, sk next dc, dc in ch-1 sp, sk next 3 dc and 2 ch sps, 5 dc in next ch-2 sp \*\*, ch 2, 1 dc in next st, rep from \* across, ending last rep at \*\*, turn.

# Flowers for Mom

(9/8/06 ar) Page 103 **Border** 

**Rnd 1:** Attach winter white at "point A" as indicated on the diagram on page 88, ch 1, sc evenly sp around entire outer edge of afghan working 3 sc in each outer corner as needed to keep piece from curling, sl st to join in beg sc.

**Rnds 2 & 3:** Ch 1, sc in each sc around, working 3 sc in center sc of 3-sc group, sl st to join in beg sc.

**Rnd 4:** Ch 1, reverse sc (working from left to right, insert hook in next st to the right, yo, draw up a lp on hook, yo, draw through 2 lps on hook) in each sc around, sl st to join in beg sc, fasten off.

*Note:* The reverse sc is for a right handed crocheter, if you are left handed work the reverse of right handed from right to left.
