## B. Dimensional Triangles

Row 3: K4, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, *k5 k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, rep from * to last 4 sts, k 4 .
Row 9: K1, k2tog, yo, k7, *yo, CDD, yo, k7; rep from * to last 3 sts, yo, ssk, k1.

## Border

Knit 7 rows.
Set up pat: Garter st over 6 sts, pm, work Dimensional Triangles pat to last 6 sts, pm Garter st over 6 sts.

## Special Abbreviations

C6R-K (Cable 6 Right [k first st of seed st section]): Slip 3 sts to cn and hold in back, $\mathrm{k} 1, \mathrm{p} 1, \mathrm{k} 1$, then k 3 from cn .
C6R-P (Cable 6 Right [p first st of seed st section]): Slip 3 sts to cn and hold in back, $\mathrm{p} 1, \mathrm{k} 1, \mathrm{p} 1$, then k 3 from cn .
C6L-P (Cable 6 Left [p first st of seed st section]): Slip 3 sts to cn and hold in front, k 3 , then $\mathrm{p} 1, \mathrm{k} 1, \mathrm{p} 1$ from cn .
C6L-K (Cable 6 Left [k first st of seed st section]): Slip 3 sts to cn and hold in front, k 3 , then $\mathrm{k} 1, \mathrm{p} 1, \mathrm{k} 1$ from cn .

## Pattern Stitch

Cables
Row 5: K3, p3, C6R-K, C6L-P, p3, *slip 1 purlwise, k2, p3, C6R-K, C6L-P, p3; rep from * to last 3 sts, k3.

Row 15: K3, p3, C6L-K, C6R-P, p3, *C3L, p3, C6L-K, C6R-P, p 3 ; rep from * to last 3 sts, k3.

Row 13: [K2, p2] twice, *k12, p2, k2, p2, rep from * to last 2 sts, k2.

## Pattern Stitches

A. Double Basketweave (multiple of 18 sts +10 )

Row 10: [P2, k2] twice, p12, k2, p2, k2, p12, [k2, p2] twice.
Row 13: [K2, p2] twice, k12, p2, k2, p2, k12, [p2, k2] twice.

Keeping 7 sts between cable panels in St st, continue to work even in established pats until 3 reps of pat C have been complete. (108 rows)

Cast on 4 sts. Knit 2 rows.
Row 1 (RS): K2, insert RH ndl from front to back into the yarn running between RH ndl and LH ndl, [yo] twice and pull through, k2.


# Cables \& Diamonds, C: Entwined Diamonds Big Needle Knit Afghans P160 

32 stitches x 36 rows


Row 1 (Right Side): P2, T2B, T2F, p7, C3B, C3F, p7, T2B, T2F, p2.
Row 2 (Wrong Side): Knit or purl the sts as they present themselves.
Row 3: P1, T2B, p2, T2F, p5, C3B, k2, C3F, p5, T2B, p2, T2F, p1.
Row 5: T2B, p4, T2F, p3, T3B, C4B, T3F, p3, T2B, p4, T2F.
Row 7: T2F, p4, T2B, p2, [T3B] 2 times, [T3F] 2 times, p2, T2F, p4, T2B.
Row 9: P1, T2F, p2, T2B, p2, [T3B] 2 times, p2, [T3F] 2 times, p2, T2F, p2, T2B, p1.
Row 11: P2, T2F, T2B, p2, [T3B] 2 times, p4, [T3F] 2 times, p2, T2F, T2B, p2.
Row 13: P3, C2B, p2, T3B, C3B, p6, C3F, T3F, p2, C2B, p3.
Row 15: P6, T3B, C3B, C2F, p4, C2B, C3F, T3F, p6.
Row 17: P5, T3B, C3B, k2, C2F, p2, C2B, k2, C3F, T3F, p5.
Row 19: P4, T3B, C3B, k4, C2F, C2B, k4, C3F, T3F, p4.
Row 21: P3, T3B, p1, T3F, k5, C2B, k5, T3B, p1, T3F, p3.
Row 23: P2, T2B, T2F, p2, T3F, k10, T3B, p2, T2B, T2F, p2.
Row 25: P1, T2B, p2, T2F, p2, T3F, k8, T3B, p2, T2B, p2, T2F, p1.
Row 27: T2B, p4, T2F, p2, T3F, k6, T3B, p2, T2B, p4, T2F.
Row 29: T2F, p4, T2B, p3, T3F, k4, T3B, p3, T2F, p4, T2B.
Row 31: P1, T2F, p2, T2B, p5, T3F, k2, T3B, p5, T2F, p2, T2B, p1.
Row 33: P2, T2F, T2B, p7, T3F, T3B, p7, T2F, T2B, p2.
Row 35: P3, C2B, p9, C4B, p9, C2B, p3.
Row 36: Repeat Row 2.

Stockinette Stitch: Knit $1(k)$ on right side rows, purl 1 (p) on wrong side rows.

- Reverse Stockinette Stitch: Purl 1 on right side rows, knit 1 on wrong side rows.
$y$ c2B: Slip next stitch onto cable needle, hold at back of work. Knit the next stitch, knit the stitch from the cable needle.
/ T2B: Slip next stitch onto cable needle, hold at back of work. Knit the next stitch, purl the stitch on the cable needle.
T2F: Slip next stitch onto cable needle, hold at front of work. Purl 1, knit the stitch on the cable needle.
/ T3B: Slip next stitch to cable needle, hold at back of work. Knit 2, purl the stitch on the cable
needle.
$\searrow$ T3F: Slip next 2 stitches onto cable needle, hold at front of work. Purl 1, knit the stitches on the cable needle.
$\searrow$ C3B: Slip next stitch to cable needle, hold at back of work. Knit 2, knit the stitch on the cable needle.
$\lambda$ C3F: Slip next 2 stitches onto cable needle, hold at front of work. Knit 1, knit the stitches on the cable needle.
C4B: Slip next 2 stitches onto cable needle, hold at back of work. Knit the next 2 stitches, knit the stitches on the cable needle.
$\lambda$ C2F: Slip next stitch onto cable needle, hold at front of work. Knit 1, knit the stitch on the cable needle

Stitch Key
$\square$ Stockinette Stitch: Knit 1 (k) on right side rows, purl 1 (p) on wrong side rows.

Y c2B: slip next stitch onto cable needle, hold at back of work. Knit the next stitch, knit the stitch from the cable needle.
/ / T2B: Slip next stitch onto cable needle, hold at back of work. Knit the next stitch, purl the stitch on the cable needle.
$\searrow$ T2F: Slip next stitch onto cable needle, hold at front of work. Purl 1, knit the stitch on the cable needle.
/ T3B: Slip next stitch to cable needle, hold at back of work. Knit 2, purl the stitch on the cable needle.
$\searrow$ T3F: Slip next 2 stitches onto cable needle, hold at front of work. Purl 1, knit the stitches on the cable needle.
$\searrow$ C3B: Slip next stitch to cable needle, hold at back of work. Knit 2, knit the stitch on the cable needle.
$\lambda \quad$ C3F: Slip next 2 stitches onto cable needle, hold at front of work. Knit 1, knit the stitches on the cable needle.
C4B: Slip next 2 stitches onto cable needle, hold at back of work. Knit the next 2 stitches, knit the stitches on the cable needle.
$\lambda$ C2F: Slip next stitch onto cable needle, hold at front of work. Knit 1, knit the stitch on the cable needle.

C. Back Cable
(worked over 8 sts)
Row 4: $\mathrm{P} 1, \mathrm{sl} 3$ sts to cn and hold in back, $\mathrm{k} 3, \mathrm{k} 3$ from $\mathrm{cn}, \mathrm{p} 1$.

## STITCH KEY

K on RS, p on WS
P on RS, k on WS
Sl 1 to cn and hold in front, $\mathrm{k} 1, \mathrm{k} 1$ from cn
Sl 1 to cn and hold in back, k1, k1 from cn
Sl 1 to cn and hold in front, p1, k 1 from cn
Sl 1 to cn and hold in back, k1, p1 from cn
Sl 2 to cn and hold in front, p1, k 2 from cn
Sl 1 to cn and hold in back, k2, p1 from cn
Sl 2 to cn and hold in front, k 2 , k 2 from cn

Row 7: K2, *ssk, yo, k1, yo, k2tog, k1; rep from * across, k1. (6-st rep)
Row 9: K3, *yo, sl 1, k2tog, psso, yo, k2; rep from * across row. (5-st rep)
Row 11: K2, *yo, sl 1, k2tog, psso, yo, k2; rep from * across, end k1, (5-st rep)
Row 13: Rep Row 9.
Row 15: Rep Row 7.
Row 16: Purl.
Rep Rows 1-16 for pat.
Afghan
Cast on 153 sts.

Row 1: Sl 1, k1, *(k1, yo, k1, yo, k1) in same st, [ssk] 3 times, sl 2, k1, p2sso, [k2tog] 3 times, (k1, yo, k1, yo, k1) in same st; rep from * to last 2 sts, end k 2 .

## Pattern Notes

Each individual block (or diamond actually) starts by casting on 3 sts and increasing outward in St st until the desired width is achieved. Then dec are worked until piece is back to its original starting size.
Work Inc Rows as follows:
(RS): K1 M1R, knit to last st, M1L, k1.
(WS): P1, M1R, purl to last st, M1L, p1.
Yarn is used doubled throughout.

Odd-numbered rows 1-9 and 21-29 (RS): K1, [p1, k1] twice, *p7, k7, p7, k21, rep from * across, end last rep p7, k7, p7, k1, [k1, p1] twice.
Odd-numbered rows 11-19: K 1 , [p1, k1] twice, *k7, p7, k7, k 21 , rep from * across, end last rep $\mathrm{k} 7, \mathrm{p} 7, \mathrm{k} 7, \mathrm{k} 1,[\mathrm{p} 1, \mathrm{k} 1]$ twice. Odd-numbered rows 31-39 and 51-59: K1, [p1, k1] twice, *k21, p7, k7, p7, rep from * across, end last rep p7, k7, p7, k22, [p1, k1] twice.
