## Special Abbreviation

Lift: Insert right needle from front-to-back under loop of contrasting yarn. Knit next st with base color, dropping strand behind st and locking it in place.

## Pattern Notes

Circular needle is used to accommodate large number of sts. Do not join; work
in rows.
When a RS row follows a RS row, slide sts to opposite end of needle.
When slipping 5 sts, bring yarn over thumb to make loose.
When adding or cutting yarn, leave a 5-inch tail. This can be added to the fringe rather than weaving it in.

## Throw

With A, cast on 237 sts.
Knit 10 rows. Cut yarn.

## Blue Section

Row 1 (RS): With B, knit. Slide.
Row 2 (RS): With C, k1, bring yarn to front of work, sl 3 wyif, *p1, sl 5 wyif, rep from * to last 4 sts, sl 3 wyif, k1. Cut C.
Rows 3 and 5 (WS): With B, k1, purl to last st, k1.
Row 4 (RS): With B, knit.
Row 6 (RS): With B, k1, *lift C while knitting B, k5; rep from * to last 2 sts, lift C while knitting B, k1. Slide.
Row 7 (RS): With C, k1, *p1, sl 5 wyif; rep from * to last 2 sts, p1, k1. Cut C.
Rows 8 and 10 (WS): With B, k1, purl to last st, k1.
Row 9 (RS): With B, knit.
Row 11 (RS): With B, k4, *lift C while knitting B, k5; rep from *, end last rep k4. Slide.
Rep Rows 2-11 twice more. Cut B. Slide.**
Beg with a RS row, knit 6 rows A. Cut A.

## White Section

Row 1 (RS): With C, knit. Slide.
Row 2 (RS): With B, k1, bring yarn to front of work, sl 3 wyif, *p1, sl 5 wyif; rep from * to last 4 sts, sl 3 wyif, k1. Cut B.
Rows 3 and 5 (WS): With C, k1, purl to last st, k1.
Row 4 (RS): With C, knit.
Row 6 (RS): With C, k1, *lift B while knitting C, k5; rep from * to last 2 sts, lift B while knitting C, k1. Slide.
Row 7 (RS): With B, k1, *p1, sl 5 wyif, rep from * to last 2 sts, p1, k1. Cut B.
Rows 8 and 10 (WS): With C, k1, purl to last st, k1.
Row 9 (RS): With C, knit.
Row 11 (RS): With C, k4, *lift B while knitting C, k5; rep from *, end last rep k4. Slide.
Rep Rows 2-11 twice more. Cut B. Slide.
Beg with a RS row, knit 6 rows A. Cut A.
Alternate Blue and White Sections until 9 sections have been worked, ending at ${ }^{* *}$ in the Blue Section.
Beg with a RS row, knit 10 rows A.
Bind off loosely.
Fringe
Cut strands of yarn, each 10 inches long.
Holding 2 strands tog, fold each group

Pull fold of fringe through fabric. Draw ends through lp and fasten tightly.
Alternating groups of B and C , attach 12 groups in each wide section.
Attach 2 groups of A in each garter-st section between wide bands, and 3 groups in each end section.
Rep along opposite edge.
Using tapestry needle, thread tails into neighboring like-colored fringes.
Trim fringe evenly.

This blanket is worked using the intarsia method; colors are worked separately and are not carried across the back of the fabric. Wind separate small balls or bobbins for each color area. To prevent holes, twist colors on WS at color joins by picking up new color from beneath old color.
Note: Afghan in full-page photo was photographed upside down. Refer to inset photo for color sequences/cables for Squares 1 and 2.

## Blanket

## Bottom Border

Using separate small balls of yarn for each color, cast on 16 sts with $\mathrm{B}, 18$ sts with $\mathrm{A}, 18$ sts with $\mathrm{B}, 18$ sts with $\mathrm{A}, 16$ sts with B --86sts.
Knit 5 rows, working in established color pat and twisting colors on WS at color changes.
Inc row (RS): With $B, k 14$, then [inc 1 in next st] twice; with $A$, [inc 1 in next st] twice, $k 14$, [inc in next st] twice; with $B$, [inc 1 in next st] twice, k 14 , [inc 1 in next st] twice; with A, [inc 1 in next st] twice, k14, [inc 1 in next st] twice; with B, [inc 1 in next st] twice, k14--102 sts.
Next row (WS): P18 B, 022 A, p22 B, p22 A, p18 B. Cut yarns.
Color Squares 1
Row 1 (RS): Joining in new yarns in new sequence and working each color with a separate ball of yarn, *k14 A, C8B, k14 B, C8A; rep from * once more, end K14 A.
Rows 1-12: Work even in established color pat and St st, twisting colors on WS at color changes.
Row 13: *K14 A, C8A, k14 B, C8B; rep from * once, end k14 A.
Rows 14-24: Work even in established color pat and St st, twisting colors on WS at color changes. cut yarns.
Color Squares 2
Row 1 (RS): Joining in new yarns in new sequence and working each color with a separate ball of yarn, *k14 B, C8A, k14 A, C8B: rep from * once more, end k14 B.
Rows 2-12: Work even in established color pat and St st, twisting colors on WS at color changes.
Row 13: *K14 B, C8B, k14 A, C8A; rep from * once, end k14 B.
Rows 14-24: Work even in established color pat and St st, twisting colors on WS at color changes. Cut yarns.
Rep Color Squares 1 and 2 once more, then work Color Squares 1 --total of 7 rows of 5 squares across in alternating colors.
Top Border
Dec row (RS): With B, $k 14,[k 2 t o g]$ twice; with $A,[k 2 t o g]$ twice, $k 14,[k 2 t o g]$ twice; with $B,[k 2 t o g]$ twice, $k 14$, $[k 2$ tog $]$ twice, $k 14$, [k2tog] twice; with B, [k2tog] twice, k14--86 sts.
Knit 5 rows, working in established color pat and twisting colors on WS at color changes. Bind off knitwise in established color pat.

## Side Border

With RS facing and using B, pick up and knit 124 sts along 1 side of blanket.
Knit 5 rows.
Bind off knitwise on RS.
Rep on opposite side edge.
Finishing
Weave in all ends on WS, using tails to neaten color joins as necessary. Block to finished measurements.
