



Free Knitting Pattern
Lion Brand® Yarnado
Sea Grit Scarf
Pattern Number: L80160



SKILL LEVEL – Easy

SIZE

About 6 1/2 x 58 in. (16.5 x 147.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Yarnado (Art. #221)
 - 601 Typhoon 1 ball (A)
 - 607 Tempest 1 ball (B)
- Lion Brand® knitting needles size 9 (5.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle

GAUGE

15 1/2 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) over Garter st (knit every st on every row).
BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

NOTES

1. The Scarf is worked in two sections, all in Garter st (knit every st on every row).
2. The first section of the Scarf is knit, then sts for the second section are picked up along one edge of the first section.
3. The first st of each row is slipped for a neat edge. Slip stitches should be slipped as if to purl.

SCARF

First Section

With A, cast on 110 sts.

Row 1: Slip 1, knit to end of row.

Repeat Row 1 until piece measures about 6 1/2 in. (16.5 cm) from beginning.
Bind off.

Note

This Scarf doesn't have a right or wrong side. When you pick up sts to knit the Second Section, you can pick up on either side of the First Section.

Second Section

With B, pick up and knit 25 sts evenly spaced across one short end of First Section.

Repeat Row 1 of First Section until Second Section measures about 29 in. (73.5 cm) from picked up sts.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

st(s) = stitch(es)
